Community Drug Abuse Prevention Grant Program

The Community Drug Abuse Prevention Grant Program supports the commitment of the Office of Attorney General to assist local organizations in their efforts to prevent drug and alcohol abuse in Pennsylvania and to promote adherence to the Commonwealth's drug and alcohol laws.

Since its inception in 1987, the Office of Attorney General (OAG) Grant Program has awarded more than \$700,000 to parent and community groups across Pennsylvania. The OAG Grant Program is currently funded from the Substance Abuse Education and Demand Reduction Fund established by Act 198 of 2002.
